1942 HIGHWAY MAP

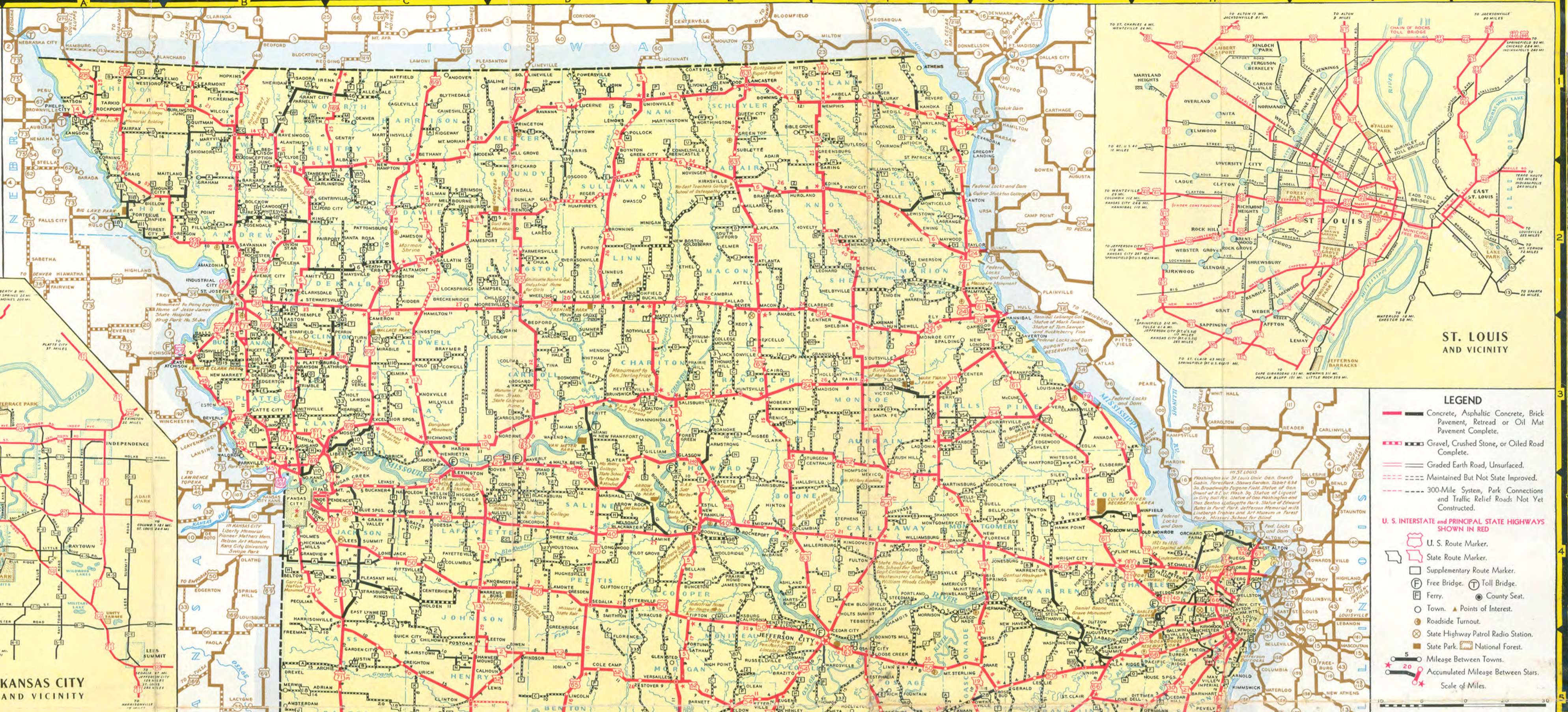
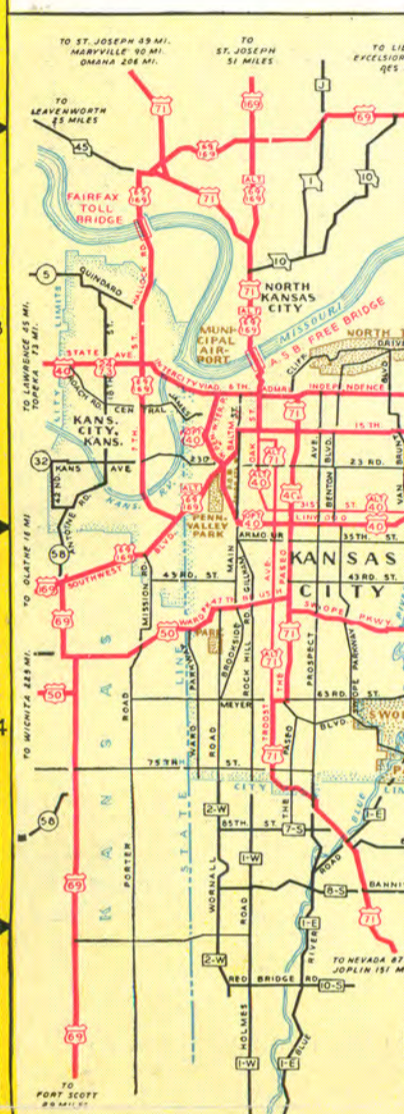
