

# Cost Share Committee Meeting - September 26, 2018



## Summary of Program Activity

- ❑ Six projects were approved for approximately \$9.1 million.
- ❑ The Program has \$1.7 million available in state fiscal year 2020, \$16.5 million available in state fiscal year 2021, \$12.5 million available in state fiscal year 2022 and \$18.0 million available in state fiscal year 2023 for cost share projects.
- ❑ The Program has \$0.1 million available in state fiscal year 2019, \$2.5 million available in state fiscal year 2020, \$3.0 million available in state fiscal year 2021, \$1.8 million available in state fiscal year 2022 and \$2.0 million available in state fiscal year 2023 for cost share projects that encourage economic development.

## Partnerships Approved

City of Eldon - \$420,021 to widen and construct turn lanes on Route 52. (Economic Development)

City of Sullivan - \$532,000 to improve the intersection of I-44 and Route 185/Route AF.

City of Carthage - \$1,333,841 to construct a roundabout and realign the southbound entry and exit ramps of I-49 to Route HH.

City of Ashland - \$948,000 to construct a roundabout at the intersection of Route M/Broadway and Henry Clay Boulevard.

City of St. Charles - \$4,975,000 to improve the Route 94/Route 364 and Muegge Road interchange.

City of Grandview - \$915,628 to improve Route 150 from Byars Road to Kelley Road.
