

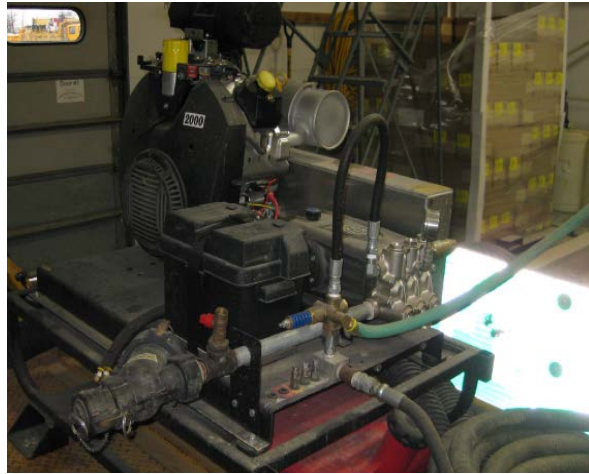

Culvert Jetter



Description

The Culvert Jetter is a single unit made to rise onto a truck with a forklift. The jetter was mounted solid to an unused trailer, and a tool box from an emergency response truck was mounted onto the trailer to store tools and nozzles.

Benefit

The Culvert Jetter saves time, simplifies work and increases safety while cleaning out culverts along right-of-way areas that are completely clogged.

Materials and Labor

40 hours of staff time with \$11,700 in materials.
