1	6.9	DBE	Section 6.9 – Disadvantage Business Enterprise states: "In an effort to ensure a healthy contracting environment for DBE contractors and consultants, a DBE can only be exclusive with one Submitter if they meet the requirements of a Major Participant as defined in Section 6.1, or with written permission of MoDOT's Project Director." Should the Submitters assume that this statement in section 6.9 limits a DBE contractor or consultant to one Submitter if they are listed as a Major Participant (defined as performing 20% or more of the construction work or professional services by Section 6.1)?	Yes. If the DBE firm is going to perform more than 20% of the work, they have to be considered as a major participant as defined by section 6.1. Furthermore, as stated in section 2.2, "MoDOT may disqualify a Submitter if any of its Major Participants (as defined in Section 6.1) belong to more than one Submitter organization.	11-25-2020	N
