



Columbia I-70 Bridges/ Business Loop 70 Fact Sheet

The Columbia I-70 Bridges Project is an \$18 million design-build project to replace the I-70 bridges over Business Loop 70/West Boulevard, Garth Avenue, and MO Route 763/Range Line Street in Columbia, Mo. Design-build is a project delivery method that combines both the design and construction phases into one contract to save time and resources. The project began in August of 2015 and is scheduled to be completed by Oct. 1.

What's Happening at Business Loop?

- Building a new I-70 bridge
- Constructing two dual-lane roundabouts on the north and south sides of I-70
- Improving access to I-70 Drive SW
- Decreasing traffic delays on Creasy Springs

How Will the Work Impact Traffic?

I-70 will remain open at all times except for a few temporary evening lane closures. Other closures:

Business Loop 70/West Blvd.	45 days
South I-70 Outer Road	30 days

What is a Roundabout?

- A roundabout is an intersection that accommodates traffic flow in one direction around a central circular island. It is used as a form of intersection control, like traffic signals or stop signs.

Why Roundabouts?

- Roundabouts increase safety and improve traffic flow.
- They allow for free flowing traffic with yield conditions that reduce crashes by as much as 75 percent.
