General Summary

The maintenance operations specialist provides operational support in the management of the roadway maintenance program. Responsibilities are performed under direct supervision.

Minimum/Required Qualifications

- Bachelor's Degree: Civil Engineering, Engineering Management, or related field. OR
- Six years of highway maintenance operations experience.

Special Working Conditions/Job Characteristics

- Job requires exposure to physical hazards, health and safety risks, and/or adverse or otherwise undesirable characteristics in the environment.
- Job may require operation of vehicles to plow snow and spread ice control materials.

Examples of Work

- 1. Supports maintenance staff in developing and revising maintenance policies, and Engineering Policy Guide procedures and guidelines.
- **2.** Assists in the analysis and preparation of maintenance related reports, correspondence, records, and presentations.
- Inspects field operations, work zones, buildings, communications networks, and road conditions, and assists in the preparation of related recommendations, correspondence, and reports.

- **4.** Supports the bridge inspection program, as needed.
- **5**. Supports the preparation of plans, specifications, and estimates for roadway maintenance contracts.
- **6.** Assists in the evaluation and review of district maintenance activities to ensure conformity with department policies.
- 7. Supports the preparation of damage survey summary reports for disaster reimbursement to the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and Federal Emergency Management Agency.
- 8. Supports the preparation of preventative maintenance plans and cost reports for federally eligible maintenance work to FHWA.
- **9**. Performs quality assurance reviews on federally eligible maintenance work.
- **10**. Performs other responsibilities as required or assigned.
