



Interstate 55 Corridor Design-Build Project

The Missouri Department of Transportation has a three-year Design-Build project, starting in 2024, that is 12 miles long. An additional lane will be added within the 8-mile section just north of the Route Z interchange (where the 3-lane section currently ends) to I-55/U.S. Route 67.

As part of MoDOT’s project, there will be changes made at three major interchanges including I-55 at Route Z, I-55 at McNutt, and the I-55/U.S. Route 67 clover-leaf interchange. Minor work will also be completed at the I-55 at Route A interchange. There is also 27 bridges that will be addressed within this project.
