A synopsis of the June 14, 2024 Cost Share Committee Meeting

Summary of Program Activity

- ❑ Three projects were approved for \$1.8 million.
- ❑ One project is pending and awaiting further action.
- ❑ MoDOT's Cost Share Program has \$1.0 million available in state fiscal year 2024, \$23.2 million available in state fiscal year 2025, \$38.6 million available in state fiscal year 2026, \$18.0 million available in state fiscal year 2027, and \$18.0 million available in state fiscal year 2028 for cost share projects.
- ❑ MoDOT's Cost Share Program has \$0.5 million available in state fiscal year 2024, \$9.0 million available in state fiscal year 2025, \$9.0 million available in state fiscal year 2026, \$4.5 million available in state fiscal year 2027, and \$4.5 million available in state fiscal year 2028 for cost share projects that encourage economic development.

Partnerships Approved

Warren County Commission - \$500,000 to construct traffic signals at the intersection of Veterans Memorial Parkway (I-70 South Outer Road) and Heartland Drive that are integrated with the railroad crossing signals.

Village of Loch Lloyd - \$201,000 to construct a traffic signal at the intersection of Route D and Loch Lloyd Parkway.

City of Warrensburg - \$1,067,004 to conduct the preliminary engineering and final design phase for the Route 50 and Maguire Street interchange and the Holden Bridge.

The Cost Share Committee's next meeting is scheduled for September 12, 2024. Applications must be submitted by July 8, 2024.
