Encroachment Solution Sign



Description and Benefit

A face-to-face conversation is always preferred to verify if a property owner has an issued MoDOT permit. The encroachment sign is intended to be a "notice" to inform property owner/contractor performing work within MoDOT right of way when no one is present and a MoDOT permit cannot be verified. Signs shall be placed parallel and at the right of way line in the vicinity of the work being performed. The Encroachment Sign is easy to tranport and utilize when unpermitted work within right of way is identified. The sign cost is more reasonable then the cost of cones, which are frequently stolen.
