

Snowplow Frame Jack



Description and Benefit

The Frame Jack is a portable method for lifting the frames of snowplows into position for attachment to trucks. It is a lot easier to use than a floor jack, especially on uneven ground. This innovation was made out of a 2,000 pound jack where we welded on a footer to support the frame and added a chain for safety. What makes this floor jack different, is that it can be operated by a half inch cordless impact, making our jobs much easier and less strenuous.
