
IMPROVE I-70 MONTHLY REPORT

Missouri's FY2024 budget from the General Assembly and signed into law by Governor Parson provides General Revenue for the costs to plan, design, construct, reconstruct, rehabilitate and repair three lanes in each direction on nearly 200 miles of Interstate 70, from Blue Springs to Wentzville.



IMPROVE I-70 PROGRAM 2024 MILESTONES

In late June 2023, Missouri's FY2024 budget from the General Assembly was signed into law by Governor Mike Parson providing \$2.8 billion in General Revenue for the costs to build a third lane of Interstate 70 between Blue Springs and Wentzville. Since that time, MoDOT's Statewide Improve I-70 Program has made significant progress on this historic investment in infrastructure. Here's a look at some of the major milestones completed in 2024.
