

The Missouri Department of Transportation is proposing to amend the state's five-year Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP).

A 7-day public comment period regarding the Administrative Amendment begins March 5, 2026 and ends March 12, 2026. The proposed Batch 2 March Administrative Amendment is attached below. The Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission approved the current Statewide Transportation Improvement Program in July 2025. Amendments occur due to unforeseen circumstances, changing conditions, or new opportunities that require a more rapid response than can be provided by an annual update.
